Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority, at an open public meeting held on October 15th, 2020 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority for the fiscal year beginning, January 1, 2021 and ending, December 31, 2021 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority will consider the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program for adoption on December 17th, 2020.
