NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Greater Wildwoods Tourism Improvement and Development Authority authorizes the increase of parking lot fees at the Wildwoods Convention Center from twenty dollars (\$20) to thirty dollars (\$30) during certain major events such as major concerts, multiple day events, etc. that would require us to have an additional level of security in place.
